

YESHUA AMONG THE NATIVES OF THE AMERICAS

We are aware that Jesus of Nazareth lived and died in Jerusalem. It is written in both civil and spiritual history. But there is also evidence that He ministered in America!

***The Record of the Three Fires* 50 -170 AD**

The story of the Ojibwe nation. They came from Jerusalem with the testimony of the Messiah. They Met the prophet Agonabish of the above records, and Nephi from the following record.

***The Record of the Nephites* 600 - 421 AD**

The Story of the tribe of Manasseh of the tribe of Joseph in the Americas. It was hidden up by Moroni [Merunhi] from the following record.

***The Record of Merunhi* 421 AD**

The Story of the Record of the Nephites being carried north.

(See also the following civil record from Chile)

***The General History of Chile* 1674 AD**

A testimony of a Spanish friar from Chile's history.

He is called Yeshua and Yahawzhowaa by them.

YESHUA IN *THE BOOK OF YAHAWZHOWAA*

Yeshua visited the Americas after his resurrection in Jerusalem. Here are the experiences that were recorded about Him at that time.

BOOK 1

To come forth by the command of the Great Spirit in the latter days, to the Giiwedining Anishinaabeg and all nations, that they may know the covenants made with their fathers, and that they are not forgotten before the throne of Heaven. Written for the convincing of the Anishinaabe, the remnant of the house of Israel, and the nations of the Earth that Yeshua is the Messiah, the Eternal Light of the world, and that all must believe in Him to inherit eternal life. - Pg. 1

1:1 And it came to pass in the thirty and fourth year after the birth of Yeshua, that He journeyed unto the land of the meeting of the great waters, even Mitchimakinak, which is the Great Turtle lying upon the deep.

7:11 The people marvelled exceedingly, saying, Who is this, that both the winds and the waters obey Him?

BOOK 2

5:23 For man liveth not by rice and fish only, but by every word that proceedeth from the Father.

6:4 Then Yeshua lifted up His voice and said, The harvest of the Father is great, but the gatherers are few; therefore will I appoint unto Myself twelve from among you, that the work be not hindered in the day of the wind and the snow.

10:3 The people of that place brought unto Yeshua a man smitten with palsy, who had lain upon his mat for twenty winters.

5 When they could not come near for the press of the people, they went up by the rocks, and let him down with cords before the feet of Yeshua. 6 And Yeshua, seeing their faith, said unto the man, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee; arise, take up thy mat, and walk. 7 Straightway the man rose, strength returning to his limbs as the sap riseth in spring, and he walked before them all.

9 But certain elders murmured, saying, Who is this that forgiveth

sins also? 10 And Yeshua answered them, That ye may know the Son of Man hath power on earth to forgive sins, I say unto thee, arise and walk.

19:2 Their food was spent, and their children cried for hunger.

3 Yeshua asked, Have ye nothing? 4 They answered, Only a handful of wild rice and two dried fish. 5 He said, Bring them to Me.

6 He sat upon a stone and lifted His eyes to heaven, giving thanks.

7 Then He gave the food to the Twelve to set before the people.

8 And it multiplied in their hands, so that all did eat and were filled.

9 They gathered twelve baskets of what remained.

20:7 The Twelve beheld a light descend upon Him as a dove.

8 A voice spake from the heavens, This is My beloved Son; hear ye Him. 9 They fell upon their faces in awe.

BOOK 3

17:14 A woman whispered, "I wish to be remembered." 15 Yeshua answered, "Thou already art." 16 He healed her of the bleeding that had afflicted her for twelve winters, and her face became as the morning. 17 He said, "Thy reflection is restored."

BOOK IV

The Mount of Transfiguration Experience

1:3 And He said unto them, Abide ye here with prayer; for I go up to the height to commune with my Father. 7 And Yeshua prayed, and the prophet watched; and there was silence as of a held breath upon the whole land. 10 Then drew near canoes of the sky, whose shapes were as the Megis shell, white and shining; their bellies glowed as the inside of a clam when it catcheth the sun upon water.

12 One stood above them like the morning star, and two kept watch on either side as guardians of a king. 14 The canoes of the sky made no shadow upon the mountain, but cast a brightness downward as a path. 15 Yeshua stood in that brightness; and His raiment was white as froth upon a river-stone, and His face shone as the rising over Gichigami. 16 A voice as many waters spake not to the ears but to the inward man: This is my beloved Son; hear ye Him. 18 Then were seen within the brightness two elders of glory, having the countenance of law and of prophecy, speaking with Yeshua of a journey yet to be fulfilled.

War stopped with one word:

5:1 Before the light, the men of the Anishinaabe and the men of the Dakota set themselves in order: shields painted, spears dressed, bows strung; and the drum beat as a heart that knoweth only haste.

2 Yeshua came forth alone between the ridges, and stood in the hollow where the river bended like a bow. 4 He lifted His hands and cried with a great voice, Peace, children of one Maker!

5 But the lines advanced, for wrath hath a hunger that heedeth not bread. 6 Then did Yeshua step into the very midst, where the first spears would have met; and the Twelve cried out; and the women lifted their hands to heaven. 7 He said, Abba! and a pillar of light descended and stood upon Him, not burning, neither blinding, but making all things plain. 8 The sound of the world fell away; the drum was as though it had never been; only His voice remained. 9 He spake the names of the chiefs of both sides, one by one, with the names wherewith their mothers had called them; and the spears hung in the air as if the earth herself had taken hold.

10 He told the secret grief of each, not to shame but to heal; and wounds in the flesh were knit even as He spake, and old scars cooled as though washed in first snow. 11 He stretched forth His hands to the east and to the west; and the weapons became as stones too heavy for wrath to lift. 12 The young men trembled, for their arms were as water; and their eyes were fountains. 13 Yeshua cried, Whom seek ye to kill? Thine own future? Thy children's laughter? Thy father's prayer?

BOOK VI The Travel OF Lhii [Lehi] from Israel

7:1 I, Lhii [Lehi], son of a house once noble in Zho-ru-som [Jerusalem], lift up my voice that the keeping be sure. 4 In the night a voice visited me, soft as dew yet sharp as flint, saying, Arise and go.

5 I beheld a sea stretched from the dawn unto the sunset, and a far shore bright with painted people. 6 Their hands were lifted to heaven; their faces wore the colours of earth; peace was upon their eyes. 7 The voice said, Cross, O Lhii; for thy seed shall be joined with theirs, and I will remember both in the latter days. 8 I gathered the record of my fathers, even the Red Tablets, carved with a fire-chisel before the waters covered the old world.

BOOK VII [See Record of the Nephites 3Nephi 4:9-32]

1:2. For a **great destruction** had moved across the face of the North American continent, and there was no place where its shadow had not passed, neither the valleys nor the high places, neither the forests nor the rivers, neither the dwellings of the many nor the lodges of the few.

3. Some cities were **swallowed by the earth**, and their towers sank into the darkness, and the cries of the people were stilled beneath the weight of stone and soil.

4. And some were **burned by fire** that fell from the heavens, and the smoke thereof covered the sun, and the day was as night.

5. And some were **drowned by waters** that came in from the seas, and the waves carried away their walls and their marketplaces, and there was no remembrance of their former beauty save in the minds of those who escaped.

10:15. Agonabish read the verses aloud with **Hebrew cadence** in the heart of Anishinaabe, and the parallels walked like paired deer: and it came to pass... and behold... and thus...; and the words learned to carry each other.

This record bears witness that Israelites came here from the other side of the sea. The record starts the same time as Christ's visit in the *Record of the Nephites* [34AD]. **Jahawzhoaa** healed, ministered and taught as He did in Israel.

After Jahawzhoaa returned to heaven, the prophet he chose, Agonabish, continued ministering and began to preach in His name and began the next record: The Book of the Covenant; written on Silver Plates. Witness the gospel of Christ preached: the death, burial and resurrection of Yeshua, with believers being baptized.

YESHUA IN THE BOOK OF THE COVENANT

Yeshua died -

12:27 "What is thy teaching?" And he said, "That **Yeshua bore our sins, died**, and rose again, that we might live."

13:4. Their chief asked, "What is the burden thou carriest?" And he laid open the record, saying, "The testimony of Yeshua, the **Son of the Eternal, who walked among men, who suffered, who died, who rose again, and who shall return.**"

14:33. He taught them, "Yeshua is not far from you; He is nearer than breath. **He bore your sins**, your wounds, your griefs. **He died, He rose, and He calls you.**"

Yeshua was slain

5:11. And he opened the record, and read of the covenant, and testified of Yeshua, saying, "He is the **Son of the Most High, slain** for the sins of the world, and risen with healing in His wings."

6: 3. Then the youth lifted the record high, though his arms shook, and said with a loud voice, "I am not of myself, neither do I come by craft nor by the will of man, but I am sent to testify of Yeshua, the **Son of the Eternal Father, who was slain yet liveth**, who bore upon Himself the sins of all flesh, and whose rising conquereth the grave. I am but a vessel of clay, yet within me is a fire that shall not be quenched."

9:12. But a keeper of thunder-songs—kinsman to the proud priest of other shores—challenged, "Command the storm if you speak for heaven." The youth answered, "The sign given is this: **Yeshua was slain and He rose**; the storm obeyed Him once, but love obeys Him always."

Slain and risen

10:3. "Who art thou, that comest among us with strange burdens?" And he answered, "I am a witness of **Yeshua, the Son of the Eternal, who was slain for all nations and who rose again**, that even death might be broken."

11:4. They saw him approach and wondered, for his garments were torn by travel, yet his eyes were bright with fire. They said, "What drives thee, stranger, to climb where even hunters faint?" And he

answered, “The Spirit of the Eternal, for I bear the name of **Yeshua, the Son who was slain and is risen.**”

14:3. They received him with wonder, saying, “From whence hast thou come, O traveler of fire, for thy face is worn by many suns and thy garments by many winters?” And he answered, “I come not of myself but by the hand of the Eternal, bearing the testimony of **Yeshua, who is the Son of the Living God, slain and risen, that all peoples might live.**”

5:28. And he declared unto them the story of His birth, His teachings, His death upon the tree, **and His rising again the third day.**

Baptism

6:34. And many were **baptized** in rivers, confessing their sins, lifting their voices in thanksgiving; and the youth wrote these things upon the record, that the generations to come might not forget.

8:28. He awoke with courage, and went boldly into the next village, teaching of Yeshua’s cross, His wounds, His triumph, and His love. And many were **baptized**, confessing their sins, rejoicing as though clothed in new garments.

10:12. But he departed by night with those who had believed, and by the river he **baptized** them in its cold water, saying, “As Yeshua descended into death and rose again, so do ye rise from this water into new life.”

11:18. “If thy Teacher is **living water**, then give us drink.” And he prayed in Yeshua’s name, and the spring broke forth from cracked earth, and they drank... 19. They bowed, crying, “Surely the Creator walks with this man.” And many desired **baptism**, and he led them into the spring, burying them in water, raising them into joy.

15:19. Then many of the People of the Tall Cliffs believed, and they were **baptized** in their river, their songs echoing against the stone walls as hymns unto Yeshua.

16:23. So they baptized many in the waters of the lakes, both men and women, old and young. And Chief Eyanah himself was **baptized**, laying aside his spear, saying, “Henceforth I serve the Eternal through Yeshua.”

19:38. Ayonha, nearing his death, called Shenat and Nema and Arel, and blessed them, saying, “I have seen many dreams, but the greatest is this: **Yeshua will return**, and all tongues shall confess Him. Hold fast until that day.”

YESHUA IN THE RECORD OF THE THREE FIRES

The Ojibwe and Oganibish [Agonabish]

Matt 7:4. And the eldest among them rose, leaning upon his staff, and his voice was steady though his body was worn by years. 5. And he said: We saw him lifted up. 6. And at these words a hush fell upon the gathering, and even the children were silent. 7. And he said: We stood afar off, for fear had scattered us, yet our eyes did not turn away.

8. And we saw the Messiach fastened to the wood, his hands pierced, his feet bound, and the weight of men's cruelty laid upon him. 9. And we saw the sky darken, and the earth tremble, and the city cry out in confusion. 10. And we heard him speak words of mercy even in his suffering, praying not for vengeance, but for forgiveness. 11. And another elder rose and said: We saw him give up his breath, and we believed all hope had departed. 12. And he said: We mourned, for we had trusted that redemption would come swiftly, yet it came not as we expected. 13. And a third elder stood and said: But death did not hold him. 14. And the people drew in their breath, for the words pressed upon their hearts. 15. And he said: We saw him again, alive, bearing the marks of the nails, yet filled with life. 16. And he walked among us, not as one returned to claim rule, but as one come to teach peace.

17. And he ate with us, and he blessed us, and he opened the meaning of the Law and the prophets. 18. And he said that all things written were fulfilled in him, and that repentance and mercy were to be preached among all peoples. 19. And he breathed upon us, and we were strengthened, though we did not yet understand fully.

20. And Oganibish stood and said: I also saw him, not upon the cross, but after the darkness, when he came among my people. 21. And I touched his hands, and I knew the wounds were the same. 22. And I heard his voice, and it was the same voice that spoke peace across the waters of many lands. 23. And when these testimonies were spoken together, the people of the land were struck with awe, and many bowed themselves.

Hananyah

13. For I was in Jerusalem. 14. I walked her streets when the stones still stood, and I heard the psalms rise from the House while smoke yet ascended in order. 15. I was there when fear crept like a shadow at midday, and zeal sharpened the tongues of men. 16. I saw brothers turn upon brothers in the name of righteousness. 17. I saw the city harden its heart even as the prophets' words echoed from the walls. 18. And I saw Yeshua ben Yosef. 19. I saw him walk among the people, not as one seeking notice, but as one carrying authority that required none. 20. I heard him speak of the kingdom of Heaven, not as a place seized, but as a life entered. 21. I saw the sick healed, not by command shouted, but by compassion released. 22. I saw the proud angered, not because he sinned, but because he refused their thrones. 25. I stood afar off. 26. I watched him lifted up. 27. I saw the nails driven. 28. I heard the mockery of men who believed power proved truth. 29. I felt the earth shake when he yielded his breath. 30. And I believed, for a moment, that hope had died. 31. But death did not claim him. 32. For I saw him again. 33. I saw the wounds remain, yet no corruption touched him. 34. I heard him speak peace to those who had fled. 35. I felt the weight of mercy fall heavier than judgment ever could. 36. And I knew then that the Messiach had come—not to rule nations, but to unbind souls. 37. And when the House was burned, and the city fell, I remembered his words and knew that stone had never been the covenant. 38. And when we crossed the waters, and light rose from the sea, I knew that Heaven had not abandoned the scattered. 39. And now I stand before you, not to be honored, but to warn you with love.

Following this, we have the evidence of Christ in America recorded by the Remnant of Jacob - the seed of Joseph, in the ***Record of the Nephites***. They came to the Americas about 600BC. Therein, we see the destruction that took place in 34AD, as testified in Book VII of the book of Yahawzhowaa, above. The prophet ordained by Christ at that day, Nephi, later visited with Agonabish and Hananyah of the above records between 75 and 90 AD.

YESHUA IN *THE RECORD OF THE NEPHITES*

Prophecy of his coming to the Americas

Hel 5:54 And now it came to pass that Samuel, the Lamanite, did prophesy a great many more things which can not be written.

55 And behold, he said unto them, Behold, I give unto you a sign: for five years more cometh, and behold, then cometh the Son of God to redeem all those who shall believe on his name.

56 And behold, this will I give unto you for a sign at the time of his coming; for behold, there shall be great lights in heaven, insomuch that in the night before he cometh, there shall be no darkness, insomuch that it shall appear unto man as if it was day;

57 Therefore there shall be one day and a night, and a day, as if it were one day, and there were no night; and this shall be unto you for a sign; for ye shall know of the rising of the sun, and also of its setting;

58 Therefore they shall know of a surety that there shall be two days and a night; nevertheless the night shall not be darkened; and it shall be the night before he is born.

59 And behold there shall be a new star arise, such an one as ye never have beheld; and this also shall be a sign unto you.

60 And behold this is not all, there shall be many signs and wonders in heaven.

His coming to the Americas

3Nep 1:10 Now it came to pass that when Nephi, the son of Nephi, saw this wickedness of his people, his heart was exceeding sorrowful.

11 And it came to pass that he went out and bowed himself down upon the earth, and cried mightily to his God, in behalf of his people; yea, those who were about to be destroyed because of their faith in the tradition of their fathers.

12 And it came to pass that he cried mightily unto the Lord, all that day; and behold, the voice of the Lord came unto him, saying, Lift up your head and be of good cheer, for behold, the time is at hand, and on this night shall the sign be given,

13 And on the morrow come I into the world, to shew unto the world that I will fulfill all that which I have caused to be spoken by the mouth of my holy prophets.

14 Behold, I come unto my own, to fulfill all things which I have made known unto the children of men, from the foundation of the world, and to do the will, both of the Father, and of the Son of the Father, because of me, and of the Son, because of my flesh.

15 And behold, the time is at hand, and this night shall the sign be given.

Destruction during his death

4:6 And it came to pass in **the thirty and fourth year**, in the first month, in the fourth day of the month, there arose a great storm, such an one as never had been known in all the land; 9 ...and there was a **great and terrible destruction in the land southward**.

10 But behold, there was a more **great and terrible destruction in the land northward**: for behold, the whole face of the land was changed, because of the tempests, and the whirlwinds, ...and the exceeding great quaking of the whole earth; 30 And behold, that great city Moronihah have **I covered with earth**, and the inhabitants thereof, to hide their iniquities and their abominations from before my face, that the blood of the prophets and of the saints shall not come up any more unto me against them. 31 And behold, the city of Gilgal have **I caused to be sunk**, and the inhabitants thereof to be buried up in the depths of the earth; 28 Behold, that great city Zarahemla have **I burned with fire**, and the inhabitants thereof. 36 And behold, that great city Jacobugath, which was inhabited by the people of the king of Jacob, have I caused to be **burned with fire**, because of their sins and their wickedness, which was above all the wickedness of the whole earth,...

29 And behold, that great city **Moroni** have **I caused to be sunk in the depths of the sea**, and the inhabitants thereof to be drowned. 32 Yea, and the city of Onihah, and the inhabitants thereof, ...and the city of Jerusalem, and the inhabitants thereof, and **waters have I caused to come up in the stead thereof**,

His appearance in the Americas

3Nep 5:8 And it said unto them, Behold, my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased, in whom I have glorified my name, hear ye him.

9 And it came to pass as they understood, they cast their eyes up again towards heaven; and behold, they saw a man descending out of heaven;

10 And he was clothed in a white robe, and he came down and stood in the midst of them, and the eyes of the whole multitude were

turned upon him, and they durst not open their mouths, even one to another, and wist not what it meant, for they thought it was an angel that had appeared unto them.

11 And it came to pass that he stretched forth his hand, and spake unto the people, saying, Behold I am Jesus Christ, of whom the prophets testified should come into the world:

12 And behold I am the light and the life of the world, and I have drunk out of that bitter cup which the Father hath given me, and have glorified the Father in taking upon me the sins of the world, in the which I have suffered the will of the Father in all things,....

13 And it came to pass that when Jesus had spoken these words, the whole multitude fell to the earth, for they remembered that it had been prophesied among them that Christ should shew himself unto them after his ascension into heaven.

14 And it came to pass that the Lord spake unto them, saying, Arise and come forth unto me, that ye may thrust your hands into my side, and also that ye may feel the prints of the nails in my hands, and in my feet, that ye may know that I am the God of Israel, and the God of the whole earth, and have been slain for the sins of the world.

15 And it came to pass that the multitude went forth, and thrust their hands into his side, and did feel the prints of the nails in his hands and in his feet;

His prophecy for the Americas in our day

1 But if they [gentiles] will repent, and hearken unto my words, and harden not their hearts, I will establish my church among them, and they shall come in unto the covenant, and be numbered among this the remnant of Jacob, unto whom I have given this land for their inheritance, and they shall assist my people, the remnant of Jacob;

2 And also, as many of the house of Israel as shall come, that they may build a city, which shall be called the New Jerusalem;

3 And then shall they assist my people that they may be gathered in, who are scattered upon all the face of the land, in unto the New Jerusalem. 4 And then shall the power of heaven come down among them; and I also will be in the midst, and then shall the work of the Father commence, at that day even when this gospel shall be preached among the remnant of this people.

5 Verily, I say unto you, At that day shall the work of the Father commence among all the dispersed of my people; yea, even the

tribes which have been lost, which the Father hath led away out of Jerusalem.

The testimony of Moroni [Merunhi]

Ether 5:39,40 And now I, Moroni, bid farewell unto the Gentiles, yea, and also unto my brethren whom I love, until we shall meet before the judgement seat of Christ... And then shall ye know that I have **seen Yeshua**, and that he hath talked with me face to face,

Mormon 4:4 ... therefore I [Moroni] will write and hide up the records in the earth, and whither I go it mattereth not.

YESHUA IN THE RECORD OF MERUNHI

1: 3. I was born in a land of many rivers, where the mountains bowed their heads to the dawn. 4. My father was a Jessakid, a seer among the Midewiwin, a keeper of the covenant of Heaven. 7. We worshipped the Father of Heaven, and called Him by His true name, for His spirit was our breath. 8. And the Son, whom He sent, even Yehozhua, walked once among our fathers. 47. And I, Merunhi, begin my record in the name of the Father of Heaven, and of His Son, Yehozhua, the Living One.

2:15. The sun rises behind me as I continue north. Smoke trails over the cities like the aftermath of judgment. I feel neither fear nor victory, only a steady calling. I speak aloud as I walk: “Yehozhua lives. I have **seen the holes in His hands**.”

6:1. And it came to pass that after many days I reached the mountains of the north, ...and there I found the remnant of the Midewiwin who had not bowed to the worship of violence. 3. And when they saw **the plates upon my back** they knew what I bore, for the record has its own light that reveals itself only to those who love truth more than triumph.

6:33. And thus I close this portion of my record, **sealed in the hill of the north**, that the children of the latter days may know that peace was planted even in the ashes,...

8:11. The memory of Yehozhua remains my comfort. **I saw Him** once with my own eyes, and that moment is carved deeper into me than these words in metal. 12. **His hands bore the holes of sacrifice**, yet His eyes held no bitterness. He lives...

YESHUA IN THE GENERAL HISTORY OF CHILE (1674):

One of the men from the Catholic church, Valdivia, wanted to “build a temple for the worship and adoration of the True God who is in heaven...” To which they replied that they already knew that there was a God who dwelled in heaven, because they had heard their ancestors say that long ago a wonderful man had been in this mountain range, with a long beard and wearing sandals and a cloak, in the same way that they wore their cloaks over their shoulders, and

that he made it rain and caused the plants and crops to grow, and with a single breath he could ignite fire, and perform other wonders: suddenly healing the sick and giving sight to the blind. “And in the language of this land he spoke with such fluency and elegance as if he had always lived there, using very sweet and new words for them, telling them that high in the heavens was the Creator of all things and that He had with Him a great number of men and women who shone like the sun [angels?] and that shortly afterward he went to Peru... From which it is inferred that this man was some Apostle whose name they do not know. Valdivia was astonished...”

Various records, all testifying that Yeshua came to the Americas and taught and ministered the same as He did in Israel. In the mouth of 2 or 3 witnesses, shall every word be established. So it is.

Yeshua, The Christ, visited the Americas.

He is truly the Son of God and there is now beginning a gathering of the Remnant of Jacob - the indigenous peoples - on this land, as is prophesied in the Record of the Nephites.

This record has come to us because it testifies that the remnant of Jacob will be gathered together upon this land and together with the repentant gentiles will build a holy city unto the Lord. That is our call!
